

REGULATIONS:

1. Late entries will only be accepted on payment of late entry fee. (Late entry fee €50.00) **Entries without fee or Registration Number will not be accepted.**
2. Athletes must be registered with AAI for 2008 season.
3. Men's Teams are limited to **Twelve** competitors with **Six** to score, not more than 15 (12 plus 3 reserves) must be entered. Women's teams are limited to **Eight** competitors with **four** to score, not more than 11 (8 plus 3 reserves) must be entered
4. All competitors must wear county colours.
5. **Junior** athletes must be aged 16 years or over and under 20 years on 31st December of the year of competition (**Born 1989, 90, 91 & 92**)
6. **Senior** athletes must be aged 16 years or over on 31st December of the year of competition.
7. **U23** athletes must be aged between 20 years and under 23 on 31st December in the year of competition i.e. (**Born 1986, 87 & 88**) **U23 ATHLETES MUST DECLARE AND MUST INDICATE THIS ON THE ENTRY FORM BY TICKING THE APPROPRIATE BOX**
8. **Only those athletes** (including reserves) named on the entry form will be allowed to compete.
9. Birth Certificates may be requested

Motion passed at Congress 2008 re grading: "That in the matter of graded teams within a competition, the last finishing team in a grade shall not be relegated where there exists in that grade a team that has not competed within that grade. Such non-competing teams shall be relegated instead. Where there is more than one such team, lots shall be drawn to determine the team to be relegated.
