
#### **Registration and Information**

- ❖ You will need to provide valid proof of identification i.e. Passport, National ID card or equivalent and you will be required to sign the race entry form.
- ❖ You will receive your race number and race pack. Race pack includes race numbers, wrist band, drop bag, drop bag identification tag, goodie bag, t-shirt, buff.
- ❖ The wrist band will need to be worn throughout the weekend's events. It will allow competitors access to pre and post-race refreshments.
- ❖ We will only be accepting the provided drop bag to which you will attach the identification tag that came with your race number. Please ensure this is returned to the drop bag collection area at registration before close of registration on Friday. We will be unable to accept drop bags outside of registration times. All drop bags will be taken to the finish line for you. Please keep drop bag items to a minimum.
- ❖ Parking: You can receive a free parking disc on request which allows free parking for Saturday at Suir Island carpark: Suir Island, Old Bridge, Clonmel. Please note there is a limited number of spaces. There are additional public parking spaces available throughout the town.
- ❖ Information: There will be an information help desk set up at Hillview. If you have any queries or questions, please ask there.
- ❖ Doping Control: All competitors are liable to be requested to submit to a doping test before or after the competition. Number of doping controls will be determined by jury.
- ❖ Medical: Extensive medical coverage will be provided throughout the event.
- Physiotherapy: Physiotherapists will be available at race headquarters throughout Saturday.
- ❖ Thanks to the Office of Public Works (OPW), we have a limited number of free passes to a number of visitor destinations in County Tipperary. If interested, please ask at race registration.

#### Start and Finish line





The finish line is at Holy Year Cross which is situated above the town of Clonmel. There will be a medical tent, refreshments and at the finish line. Toilets will be approx 300m away at mountain entrance. Athletes can collect their drop bags at the finish line. There is approx. 3km walk from the finish line to race headquarters in Hillview Sports Club. Please follow the signs and not the race route on return to race headquarters.

# **Long course**: Distance 10.5km


Ascent 635m Descent 345m






#### **Short Course**


