

Overseas Police Clearance

If you have spent a cumulative period of 12 months or more, (i.e. when you add all the periods of time together, it amounts to 12 months or more) outside of the Republic of Ireland or Northern Ireland after the age of 18, you must submit a copy of your <u>national police</u> <u>clearance</u> (not state clearance) for each country where you lived.

These clearance certificates must cover the entire period of residence in each country. The clearance must be dated not more than six months prior to leaving the country or can be dated any time after you have left the country.

- Providing a clearance certificate is the responsibility of the applicant.
- You are advised to seek the clearance as early as possible as this process can take time.
- Your application for registration cannot be finalised until we receive your clearance.

Northern Ireland

If you have lived in Northern Ireland, you do not need to provide police clearance. The National Vetting Bureau carries out checks on both the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland checks.

Exceptional circumstances

Applicants are responsible for obtaining national police clearance certificates and should make every effort to do so.

If a satisfactory police or criminal records disclosure is not available, we reserve the right to seek a sworn Fit and Proper Person Declaration from you. The declaration must be signed, dated, and stamped by a practicing solicitor or a Commissioner for Oaths.

You do not need the clearance if the applicant:

- Was travelling through the country and had no fixed address
- Resided in the country for a period of less than six months
- Resided in the country more than 10 years ago and has provided correspondence
- proving that police clearance cannot be obtained.
